

**PUBLIC NOTICE
RECOVERY TASK FORCE
WORKSHOP**

The Lee County Recovery Task Force will host a public workshop on Monday, June 5 from 9:00 AM - 5:00 PM at Collaboratory, located at 2031 Jackson St., Fort Myers, FL, 33901. The following critical infrastructure topics will be discussed:

- A. Protecting, restoring, and enhancing natural resources supporting health and resilience.
- B. Ensuring resilient supportive infrastructure for the Lee County region - roads, highways, fuel, and transport.
- C. Identifying the infrastructure (water) projects that would provide the greatest resilience value in defending key infrastructure assets.
- D. Identifying the infrastructure (power) projects that would provide the greatest resilience value in defending key infrastructure assets.

Beginning June 5, the Recovery Task Force will be hosting a series of workshops designed to engage subject-matter experts in the Recovery and Resilience Planning process. The workshops will include presentations and discussions from expert panelists that inform the Recovery and Resilience Plan and allow for public participation in the planning process.
